Family Catechesis

In today’s Gospel, the guests who were invited did not come, so the host invited strangers. Every Sunday, we are invited to come to God’s house. Sometimes we may not feel like going, but God is waiting eagerly for our arrival. Observe how the altar is set for our feast, the Eucharist. God has sent us an invitation to this celebration. God gathers us at the Eucharist as a community of faith joined as one voice raised in prayer. Therefore, we are a vital part of the liturgical celebration. We believe that Christ is present in the assembly of the faithful, gathered in His name. When we pray during the Eucharistic celebration, we become signs of the presence of Jesus, to one another and to the world.
