Our Lady Queen of Peace Catholic Church Baptism Information

The celebration of the sacrament of Baptism is a special occasion in the life of your family and in the life of the Church. At birth, your child was born into your human family. At Baptism, your child is born into the Church, the People of God. Just as it is good to gather the members of our immediate and extended families together for the celebration, it is fitting to celebrate Baptism in the midst of our parish family. As the people you see at Mass may be relative strangers, as baptized Christians we are united in Christ, we are members of His body, sons and daughters of the Father. We all share in what is most important, our faith in Christ.

Selecting Godparents

Godparents play a very important role in your child's spiritual life. They serve as role models of the faith. The child should be able to look to their godparent as an example of how the church teaches us to live our Catholic faith. In their role as godparent, they represent the larger Church community. Therefore, being a godparent is not only an honor, it is a tremendous responsibility. The godparents should be carefully chosen. In recognizing the importance of the godparent and their duties, the Church has provided guidelines to help parents choose the best possible godparents for their children. Our Lady Queen of Peace adheres to the Canon Law of the Catholic Church in all aspects of Baptism.

The Roman Catholic Church Requirements for Godparent

- 1. At least one practicing Roman Catholic who presently attends and is actively involved in the Roman Catholic Church.**
- 2. The godparent must**
 - a. be at least 18 years old and mature enough to understand, accept and carry out the duties of a godparent;
 - b. have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation;**
 - c. be living an exemplary life in harmony with the faith and morals of the Roman Catholic Church.
- 3. If both godparents are presently Catholic, both must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation.**
- 4. Only one godparent can be a non – Catholic.**
5. Godparents may not be of the same gender.
6. There may be no more than two godparents.

Parents and Godparents are required to attend a Baptism Session.

2. Godparent Eligibility Statement:

The Catholic godparents **MUST have the church where they received the sacrament of Confirmation fill out the portion of the form that states: CONFIRMATION VERIFICATION.**

The form can only be accepted if it is completely filled.

3. Contribution: \$15 parishioner; \$30 non-parishioner
